








Unemployment rate(%)



Government deficit/surplus(%)





General government deficit (-) and surplus (+) - quarterly data




Bulgaria has the THIRD lowest government debt (28.3%) in EU






FOREIGN DIRECT INVESTMENT



FDI Inflow by Industry(€ mln.)




FDI by host country, 1996-2014(€ mln.)







Bulgaria is the 7th least tax burden country in Forbes ranking of "Tax misery and Reform Index"






Arbitration Court at BCCI

Advantages of the Arbitration Procedure

- The parties participate in the composition of the arbitral tribunal by the nomination of the arbitrators.
- ☐ The dispute is settled by a simplified procedure notified in advance to both the parties.
- ☐ The speed is one of the greatest advantages of the arbitration. The procedure is of one instance. The cases are settled usually within 6 9 months.
- ☐ The arbitration awards are final, subject to enforcement and are stable, because they are subject to recourse only by a way of a court action.
- ☐ The arbitration procedure is cheaper. The fee is decreasing with the increase of the value of the action.
- ☐ The arbitration procedure is confidential and not public. So the arbitration is able to avoid deterioration of the relations between the parties.
- ☐ The AC at BCCI developed a new case status electronic processing software. All materials pertaining to the cases are available on an electronic carrier whereby arbitrators, experts, the parties and their legal and contractual representatives have distance electronic access to such materials.

- Verifies master films and printed barcodes


