

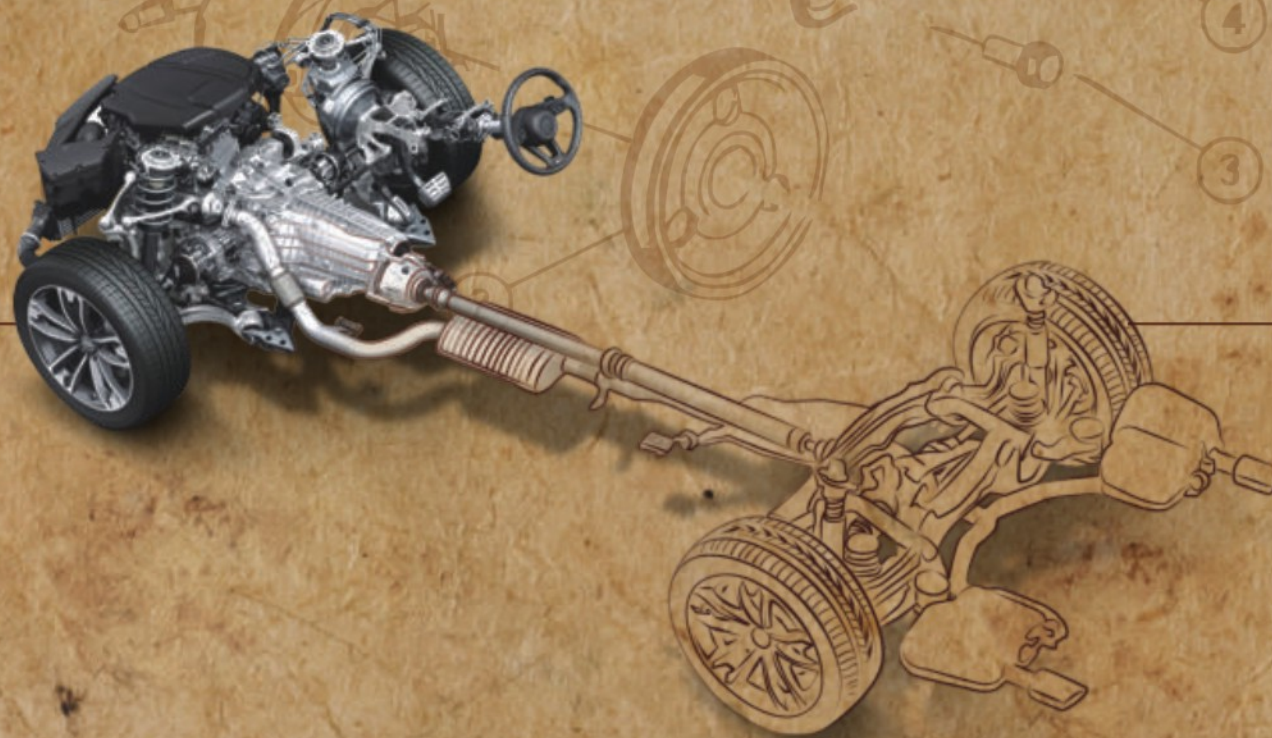

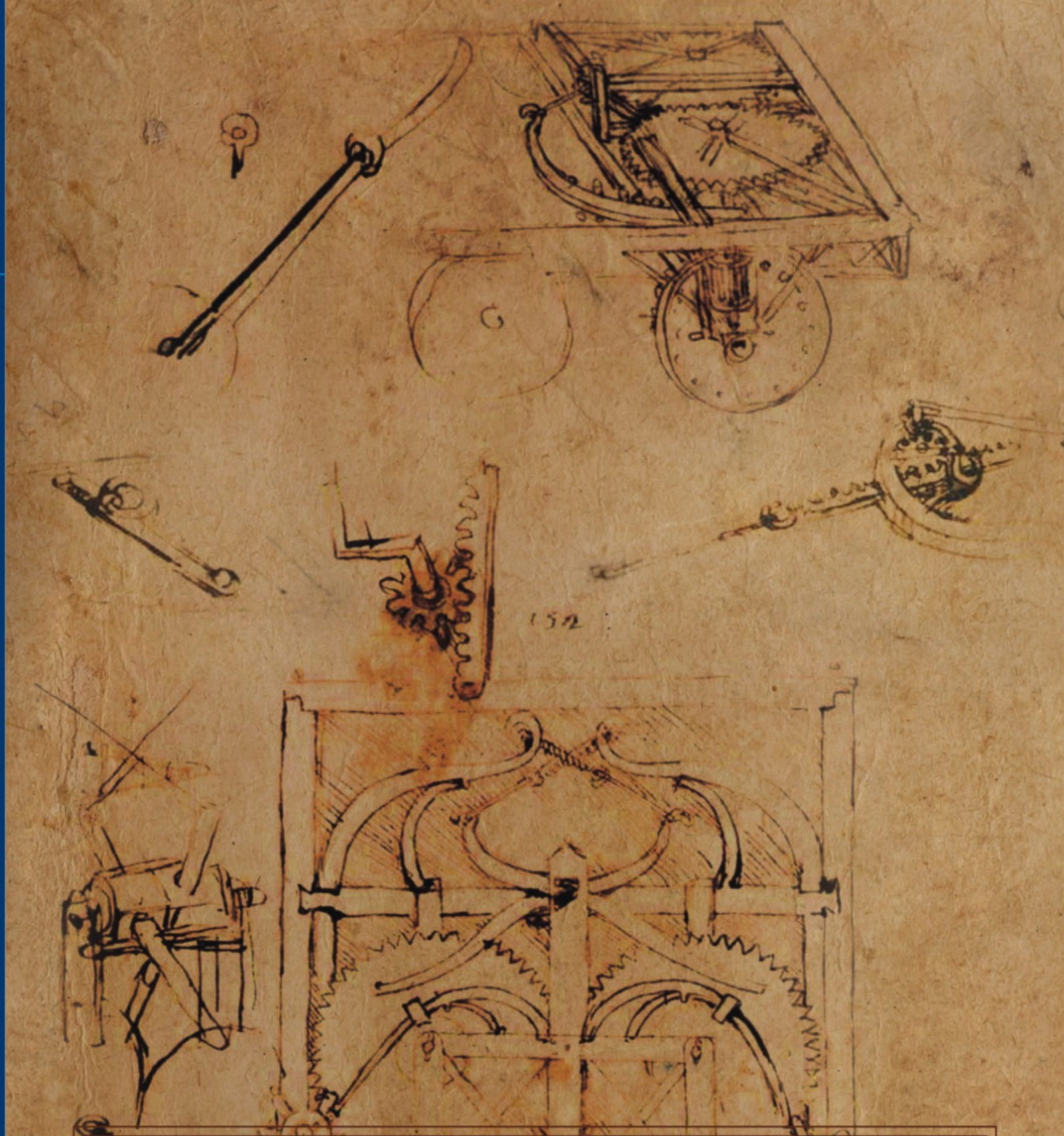

# Indian Auto Component Industry

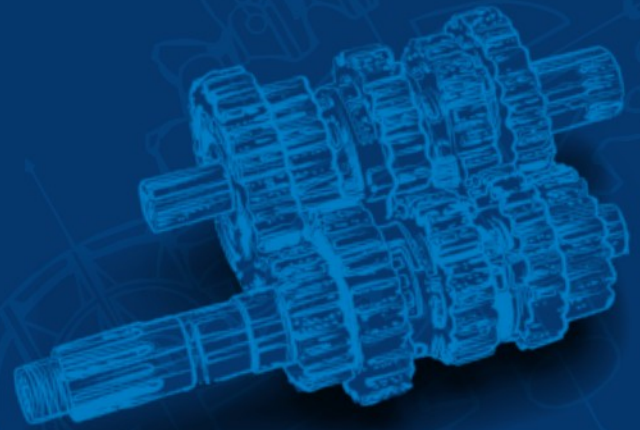
The Indian Auto-Component industry, set to become the third largest in the world by 2025, holds a distinct global competitive advantage in terms of cost and quality. According to the Automotive Mission Plan of the Government of India, the industry is expected to reach a turnover of US\$ 200 billion by 2026 from the current US\$ 38.5 billion, while exports are expected to scale up to US\$ 80 billion from the existing US\$ 11.2 billion. Indian auto-component makers are well positioned to benefit from the globalisation of the sector as exports potential could be increased by up to four times to US\$ 40 billion by 2020.

Rapid growth in vehicle consumption and the aftermarket in the domestic market together with increasing exports are fuelling the Indian Auto Component Sector. Endowed with world-class quality, advantages of skilled labour and increasing focus on technology, this industry is unbeatable.

## Road Ahead

### Government Initiatives

The Government of India's Automotive Mission Plan (AMP) 2006 - 2016 has come a long way in ensuring growth for the sector. Additionally, the deregulation of FDI in this sector has also helped foreign companies to make large investments in India. The Government of India's Automotive Mission Plan (AMP) 2016 - 2026 envisages creation of an additional 50 million jobs along with an ambitious target of increasing the value of the output of the sector to up to INR 1,889,000 crore (US\$ 282.65 billion).

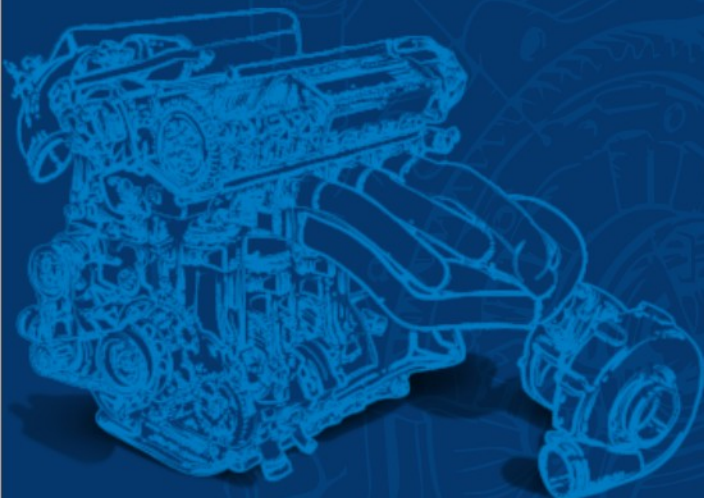


## Auto Expo 2018
