- **T+IN** will partially fill this gap and become one of the few science and technology parks in the region.






N MISSION

- It will become the platform where members of the innovation ecosystem in Bulgaria can meet, share ideas and collaborate.





- The consortium will conduct independent and collaborative fundamental and applied research, the results from which will be widely disseminated.






LIN INCUBATOR
