


Bulgarian Automotive Industry - BAI



CAPACITY

Designed annual capacity: 50,000 vehicles in two shifts; possibility to add third shift

FIRST & ONLY

The first and only automotive plant in Bulgaria to receive ISO 9001:2008 quality certificate and COP for vehicle assembly from the UK-based vehicle certification agency (VCA). The first automotive plant in EU to mass-produce WVTA certified Chinese branded vehicles.

POTENTIAL

 Possibility for in-house customs-free zone in case of further expansion into non-EU, CIS, North Africa, and Middle Eastern markets.








The project is currently with <u>phase 1 completed</u> representing:

- Logistics and spare parts warehouse for the European market
- Vehicle Stockyard
- Administrative building with a training center and canteen
- The plant was certified for vehicle assembly and for conformity of production by the UK-based vehicle certification agency (VCA).

This was the first time a quality certificate for automotive assembly has been issued to a Bulgarian assembly factory.








In 2025, BAI won a public tender and delivered 100 GWM Poer Passenger pick-up trucks to the ESO (Electricity System Operator). This is the company responsible for the coordination and management of the electricity system in the country. The Aftersales department of BAI equipped the pick-ups with hard top covers for the needs and expectations of the client. The contract states that by the end of 2025, the client may order additional 50 units of Poer pick-ups.



BAI/Bulgaria is the first market in Europe to mass-deliver YUTONG electric passenger buses

YUTONG IN BULGARIA



Bulgarian Automotive Industry, the official representative of Yutong Bus, is the first company to deliver an electric bus in Bulgaria. The electric bus was tested by the Capital City Public Transport for 6 months.

Sofia Municipality is the first Bulgarian municipality to put electric buses into operation, making it a leader in the electrification of public transportation in the region. In early 2022, the Burgas municipality received 12 9-meter Yutong E9 electric buses. The order was implemented under the Operational Programme Environment 2014-2020.

The first 14 new Yutong E12 electric buses were delivered to Pleven at the end of 2021. With this order, the city became the first Bulgarian city with 100% electric transportation.

A new Yutong E9 electric bus was delivered to Sof Connect AD, the concessionaire of Sofia Airport, at the end of 2023. This order ensured free eco-friendly transportation between the two airport terminals.
