Energy security and sustainable development remain among the most pressing global challenges, shaping economic stability, technological innovation, and strategic autonomy. Recent crises have demonstrated that energy security, affordability, and decarbonisation are closely linked, with price volatility, fragile clean technology supply chains, and strained electricity systems increasingly threatening competitiveness and social cohesion. To address these priorities, the **Center for the Study of Democracy**, the **Embassy of the Republic of Korea in Bulgaria** and the **Korea Trade-Investment Promotion Agency** are hosting the **Korea – Bulgaria Energy Roundtable** on **29 September 2026 at the Grand Hotel Sofia**.

The roundtable will bring together senior policymakers, industry leaders, investors, and experts from Bulgaria, the Republic of Korea, and European institutions. Drawing on CSD's Energy and Climate Security Risk Index (ECSRI), speakers will examine how these risks reinforce one another and how they can be mitigated to achieve secure and sustainable energy systems. The discussion will focus on the importance of strategic bilateral cooperation in nuclear energy and renewables, as well as market reform, grid and storage investments, and supply chain diversification, with the aim of building a safe and sustainable energy system and strengthening Europe's security and resilience.
